How should we behave and why?

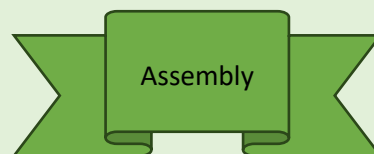

An amber warning will be given. Children to have take up time to show green behaviour.



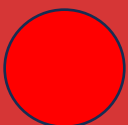
C1 – lose evergreen reward and miss 5 minutes of break.

C2 – miss 10 minutes of break.

C3 – miss 15 minutes break time.

C4 – Reflection time (45minutes) at lunchtime with Senior Leader and Behaviour monitoring report issued.

C5 – Parents will be informed and the incident recorded on CPOMS. Progression to a C5 may result in an internal or external suspension or exclusion



Children can go straight to C4 or C5 instantly depending on the behaviour.
